INTRODUCTION

This statement is made on behalf of Totaljobs Group pursuant to section 54 (1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and comprises our slavery and human trafficking statement.

OUR POLICIES ON SLAVERY AND HUMAN TRAFFICKING

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. Our Anti-slavery Policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in our business.

We expect the same high standards from all of our contractor, suppliers and other business partners, and as part of our contracting processes, we include specific prohibitions against the use of forced, compulsory or trafficked labour, or anyone held in slavery or servitude, whether adults or children, and we expect that our suppliers will hold their own suppliers to the same high standards.

ON GOING ASSESSMENT

Consistent with our risk based approach we may require employment and recruitment agencies and other third parties supplying workers to our organisation to confirm their compliance with our Code of Conduct.

As part of our on going assessment and due diligence processes we are considering of carrying out audits of our suppliers for their compliance with our Code of Conduct.
